Introduction

This 'roadshow' will introduce potential bidders of the design-build contract indicated below to the project and provide information to attract reputable international and local companies to bid.

The design-build contract package will comprise a 2,000 MLD river intake at Meghna River. approximately 500 MLD pumping station, 22 km long raw water pipeline and 500 MLD Water Treatment Plant. The successful bidder will be required to design and build the facilities and operate them for 3 vears.

The roadshow is scheduled from 14 March to 16 March 2014.

Day 1 is for site visits and days 2 and 3 will allow for a presentation of the project and one-to-one meetings with individual consortia to discuss the project in more detail with DWASA and Mott MacDonald project staff, who are assisting in the bid preparation.
